City of Renton Cedar River Trail Usage Guidelines for Organized Walks/Runs

The beautiful Cedar River Trail stretches for 4.5 miles from Lake Washington, within the Renton city limits, and connects eastward to Maple Valley. It continues to be a popular, regional, multi-use trail. To ensure the safety and enjoyment for all who use it, the City of Renton Event Permit Committee has set the following parameters for those interested in holding organized runs or walks on the Cedar River Trail.

- Organized (group) runs and walks are subject to the Event Permit Application Process and will be reviewed by the City's Event Permit Committee. To be considered for approval the following criteria must be met:
 - o The event occurs between October 1 and April 30.
 - Event dates are limited to Sunday Thursday (no Friday or Saturday dates).
 - ➤ If participation is less than 50 people, then Saturdays may be permitted (subject to the review and approval of the City's Event Permit Committee),
 - o Event participation is limited to a maximum of 250 participants.
- Organized (group) bicycle or in-line skating events or rides on the Cedar River Trail will not be allowed.
- No competitive (timed) events allowed.
- Please note that the City of Renton does not close the Cedar River Trail for events.
